

Challenge for the industry today

Capturing the full potential of your organization doesn't seem to be a swift and easy task. You might have a hunch but find it a challenge to document. Using a traditional SWOT-analysis will not take you to where you really want to be, nor will a project aiming to solve a certain issue do. The real challenge is to find the most efficient way to go from a vision to an action plan – in a relatively short time.

Service and Approach

A four step method is applied to go from today's status to a well anchored action plan aligned with set goals.

The project is initiated by gathering facts, figures and knowledge.

Topics can include:

- Assortment
- Supply chain
- Process/procedures
- Systems/setup ERP
- Methodologies
- Information support
- Performance management
- Collaboration with internal and external parties

The material can be in the form of lists and reports, process descriptions or other documentation, ongoing / finished relevant projects and interviews.

Step 1: A first workshop is held discussing status today, based on the information gathered.

Step 2: We present facts and findings, do a SWOT and include a risk- and potential analysis.

Step 3: Conclusions are drawn and scenarios are developed and presented.

Step 4: The scenarios are scrutinized in a second SWOT, also with a risk- and potential analysis. Supportive actions are identified as well as preventive actions.

Expected Outcome

The expected outcome is a well anchored, recommended action plan, ready to be launched. The buy-in of the plan is maximized as key staff has been involved in the creation process.

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
